In case of improper handling or disposal, household hazardous wastes (HHW) contaminate soil, air and water.

WHY?

These products contain **dangerous substances** that pose a **risk** to plant and animal health, as well as our own and that of future generations.

THREE STEPS FOR A **GOOD MANAGEMENT**

HANDLE

- Read labels
- Do not mix different products
- Do not smoke near products
- Wash your hands after handling

STORE

- Keep containers tightly closed
- Keep out of reach of children and animals
- Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat sources

DISPOSE

- Keep products in their original containers **or** clearly identify their contents
- Bring products to the ecocentre
